<u>We would like to collect 50 completed Hygiene Kits by October</u> <u>30th to send to Church World Service</u>

Each Kit Contains the following:

1 hand towel (measuring 15"x28" or 16"x32") (No fingertip, bath, dish or micro-fiber towels**)**

1 washcloth

1 wide-tooth comb (removed from Package)

- Must be Sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth
- No Pocket Combs or Picks
- Rattail & Combs without handles are acceptable
- 1 fingernail or toenail clipper (removed from Package)
- 1 Bath size bar of soap in original package
- 1 toothbrush in original packaging

10 standard size Band-Aids

If you make the kits yourself, **DO NOT add toothpaste**. Seal all items in a one-gallon plastic bag with a zipper closure.

Please put them together and bring them to church no later than **Thursday, October 30th** so that we may get them boxed up and shipped to Church World Service

You may bring them in any Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday between 9 am $\& 1 \ \mathrm{pm}$
