- 1 Travel-size lotion (3.4 oz. or less, fragrance-free, NEW Only) May)
- 1 Travel-size shampoo (3.4 oz. or less, NEW Only) (June)
- 1 Travel-size toothpaste (3.4 oz. or less, expiration date of 1 year) (July)
- 1 Sturdy wide-tooth comb (6" minimum teeth, packaging removed) (August)
