Pantry Pedals Bike Ministry

So Far this year, the bike ministry has given away 55 bikes to adults and 15 to children. Most of our bikes come in through the Mansfield Police Department in addition to a large number donated. Eight bikes were sold through the Rummage Sale, and we also sold an adult bike and two kids' tricycles for \$75 to augment our repair fund. We currently have \$83.85 in a savings account to purchase parts like brake cables, tires and inner tubes. All told, this year 81 bikes have gone from our mechanics' workshop to new owners. Bikes that were not salvageable were sold as scrap metal to Milliron for \$31, which was given to the General Fund to cover First Christian Church-provided electricity, heat and water used by this ministry.
